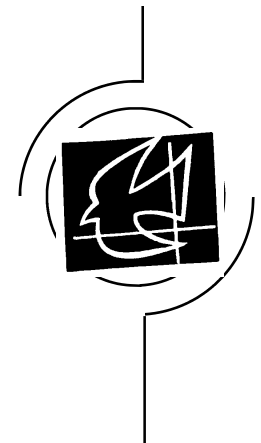
Adult Confirmation

Adult Confirmation

Many adults and young adults (beyond high school) missed out on the opportunity to be sealed in the Holy Spirit, completing their Christian Initiation and fully opening their hearts to the work of the Spirit in their lives. Because it is such an important step in the faith journey, people are unable to serve as godparents for Baptism without first being Confirmed and Confirmation is encouraged before marriage.

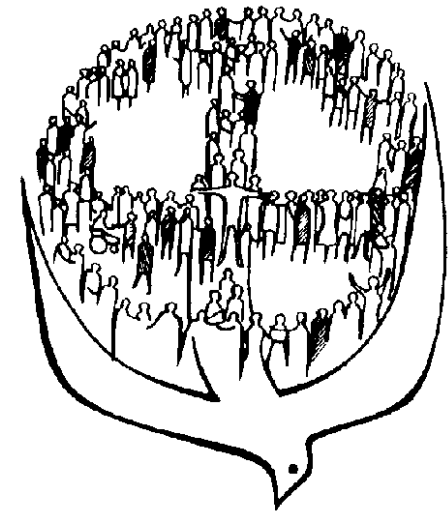
***A Rite of Welcome for those to be confirmed will take place at IHM on 9/25/11 @ 6p.m.**
